



SHYC OPENING PROCEDURES

Welcome back to the Stonington Harbor Yacht Club. We are excited to have our extraordinary members back but want to apprise you of new procedures and protocols required due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Be assured we are following state and federal guidelines and taking every precaution possible to keep you and our staff safe as we navigate these new waters.

Opening day is Thursday, June 4th. Here's what you need to know.

- All activity will be on the patio and bricks, with appropriate social distancing.
- Only the front restroom will be open initially, monitored and frequently sanitized. Other interior areas will be closed.
- In the event of poor weather, service will be curtailed.
- Club hours will be as follows:
 - Welcome Back Complimentary Coffee and Croissants
 - Thursday – Saturday, June 4-6, 7:30 to 9:00 AM
 - After the initial opening period TBD
 - Lunch
 - Wednesday-Saturday, Noon to 2:00 PM
 - Dinner
 - Wednesday-Saturday, 5:00 to 9:00 PM
 - Sunday, 5:00 to 8:00 PM
 - Beverage Service
 - Same as Lunch and Dinner hours
- Reservations must be made for lunch, dinner, and bar service. No walk-ins will be accommodated.
- Reservations may be made by calling (860) 535-0112. If we don't pick up, leave a message and we will call you back as quickly as possible.
- Everyone must have a mask on when they arrive and whenever they leave their table. It's the law.
- When you arrive, please check in with the service provider on the patio
- Please make use of our hand sanitizer station when entering the Club or returning to your table.

- Seating will be limited, so plan ahead.
- By law, table size is limited to five people and the only exception is for larger groups housing together.
- All beverages will be provided by your server. Members will not come to the bar.
- If you're not feeling well, please stay home.

ON THE WATER

- If other people are on the docks, wear a mask and keep your distance from them.
- There will be no dock hands at this time.
- As much as possible, use your vessel's head as the club's restrooms will be open only when there is service on the patio.
- Additional information and guidelines for the docks and Ideal 18s will be sent out soon.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we adapt to these requirements and changes. Among other things, leadership is working with staff to ensure proper health and sanitation training. The club will continue to monitor state, federal and health guidelines in an effort to keep everyone safe and the Club in compliance. Over time, it is our hope to increase hours and enhance services and offerings.
